

Staffers now back inside CCD's Brock Hub

The doors are open again for Community Care Durham operating out of the Brock Hub. The Township of Brock granted CCD access to the building, and staffers have begun to settle in at their desks.

COVID-19 forced the closure of the Brock Hub. Despite the closure, that hasn't stopped CCD from delivering essential services to its clients.

The Loans Cupboard is up and running. CCD loans out equipment, such as walkers, transport wheelchairs, canes, bed rails, raised toilet seats, bath grab bars, bath chairs, seats, etc. These items can be loaned up to three months to assist clients.

CCD's Hot Lunch Wednesday is operating in Brock as well as frozen Meals on Wheels available to order on Tuesdays, every two weeks, for delivery. The popular Community Food Box program is also available to clients right across Durham Region.

Due to COVID-19, The Friendly Visiting program has not returned, but Telephone Reassurance is still available.

Clients needing CCD's Transportation Services can continue to contact the Brock office for availability for both Volunteer drivers and wheelchair accessible transportation. They are a convenient option when a client cannot use public transportation or when relatives cannot help them get to appointments.

Following significant due diligence to ensure client safety, CCD's Foot Care program has resumed. The service is available to existing and new clients in Port Perry, Uxbridge and Brock.

Our COPE Mental Health Program continues to operate in Brock, providing support groups virtually.

CCD continues to monitor Provincial and Regional health directives to ensure the ongoing safe delivery of services so that clients can live independently in the community.
